



Summary of the Training Course:
“Managing your GIS project”

November 11-15, 2024, Agricultural University of Tirana



In the frame of the project *GEO-WB6 - Establishing a Geoinformation Centre for the Western Balkans*, the Agricultural University of Tirana (UBT) and the Leibniz Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies (IAMO) carried out the project’s third capacity building course on “*Managing your GIS project*” from November 11 to 15, 2024 at the campus of UBT.

A total of 18 course participants from five Western Balkan countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, North Macedonia and Serbia) came together in Tirana for five days to learn about the principles of managing a GIS project. In interactive group works and hands-on exercises, the participants were introduced to the most important aspects of collection, management, analysis and visualization of geospatial data. In groups of three persons each, they developed their own projects throughout the week and published them online at the end. The course also included an introduction to common formats of spatial data, geodatabases, and interpolation techniques.
